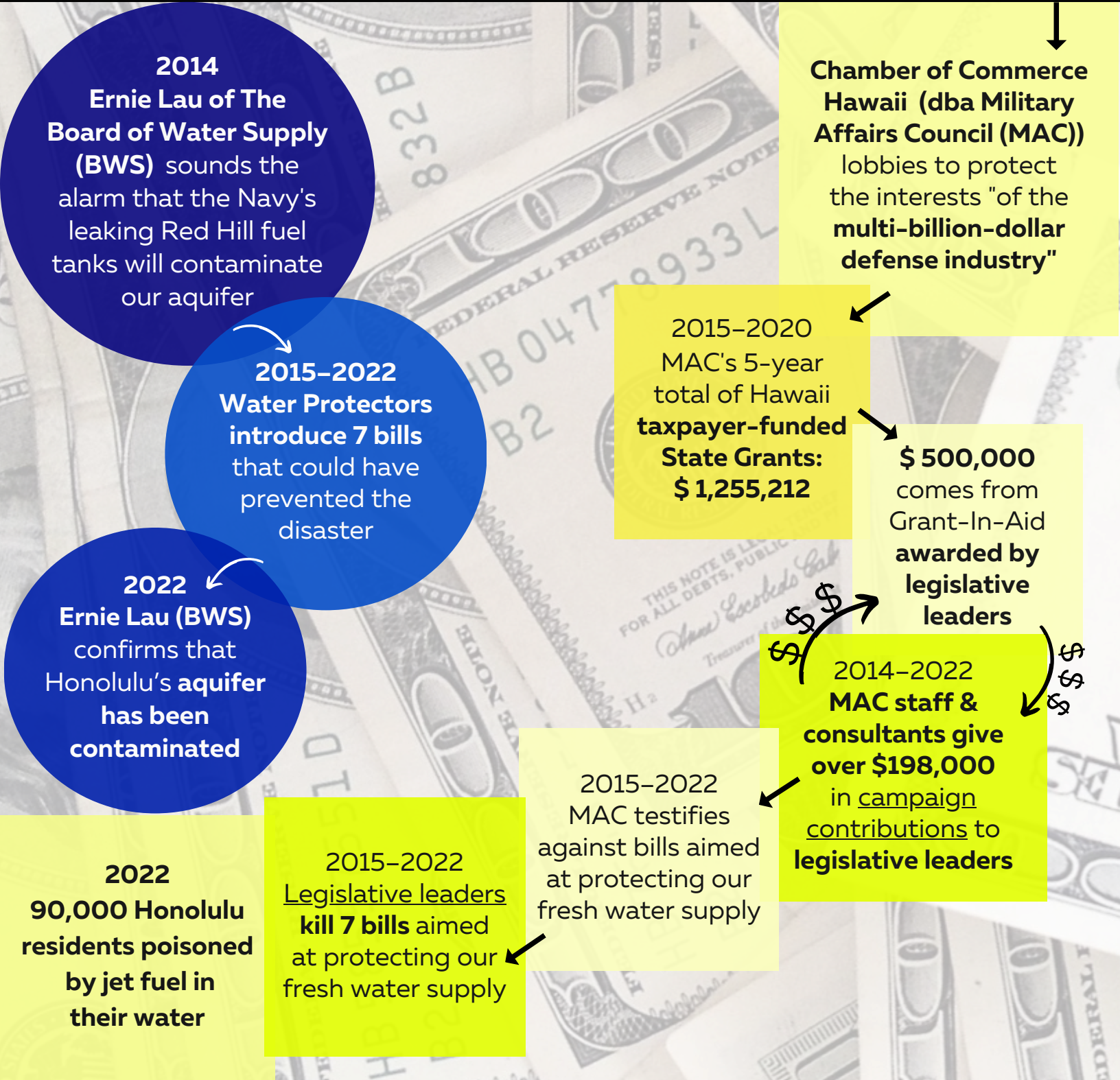


# HOW MONEY IN POLITICS IMPACTS OUR DAILY LIVES
